Affiliation Fees Q & A

1. What is an Affiliation fee?

All public and independent Schools as members of SCSA pay an affiliation fee. By paying this fee, Schools gain several benefits (as listed below). All Schools offering cycling as a sport must affiliate to SCSA.

2. Is the Affiliation fee the same as an entry fee?

No - Entry fees are still payable to the respective race organisers to participate in. Race organisers will advise how to enter and what the entrance fees for their respective races are.

3. Can our School take part in Schools events without paying affiliation fees?

No - Schools that are not affiliated will not be able to take part in inter-schools cycling events.

4. What does the school get in return for paying an affiliation fee?

Some of the benefits include:

- No additional licence fees payable to partake in SCSA events.
- Free calendar space to advertise School's events.
- Training of Team Managers, School Coaches and Commissaires.
- Professional marketing of Schools.
- Educational Programmes.
